

Amherst County At a Glance

POPULATION

As of 2019, Amherst County's estimated population was 31,605. Since 2010, it has had a population decline of 2.3 percent. About half of the population is located in the south-central portion of the county around Madison Heights near the City of Lynchburg or the town of Amherst, the county seat.

Living costs in the region are approximately 9.4% below the national average and are among the lowest in Virginia.




HEALTH CARE

The two closest hospitals to Amherst County are in Lynchburg, both south and adjacent to the county. Other hospitals serving the region are in Bedford about halfway between Lynchburg and Roanoke, and Charlottesville to the north, where the University of Virginia Medical School and Hospital is located. About 270 physicians representing all major specialties practice in the area. One nursing home is located in



the Town of Amherst, and several others are in Lynchburg. The Amherst County Community Health Center, offering primary care to people of all ages, is located in Madison Heights and the new, state-of-the-art Centra Amherst Medical Center (in the Ambriar Center) opened in 2016.



GEOGRAPHY

The County is located near the geographical center of Virginia and within 50 miles (at some points) from Roanoke and Charlottesville. Richmond is 100 miles to the east. Washington, D.C. is within 170 miles of Amherst. Elevations range from 500 ft. to 4,000 ft. providing spectacular rolling countryside. Water is abundant from the James River and many streams originate from the Blue Ridge Mountains. Most of the northwestern part of the County is part of the George Washington National Forest. The climate is mild with an average annual temperature of 56 degrees.



MONACAN INDIAN NATION ANCESTRAL MUSEUM

2009 Kenmore Rd. (off S. Main St. in Amherst) The Monacan community today centers around Bear Mountain. At this site, a log cabin was built in the late 1870s and used as a church for the Indian people. Later it functioned as a school. Today, the log cabin is a recognized National Historic Landmark.

The ancestral museum is located at this site, developed by the Monacan people with grants from the Virginia

Foundation for the Humanities, the Sweetgrass Foundation, and the Easley Foundation. The museum is equipped with the proper technology for storing and displaying artifacts, many that are now exhibited. The museum is staffed and operated by volunteers within the tribe, committed to preserving the rich legacy of the tribe's history and culture. Visits at this time are only

available by appointment. There is a \$3.00 per person fee to tour the museum. Open Tues. – Sat. 10 am. – 4 pm. Call (434) 363-4876 for hours or visit www.





AMHERST COUNTY PARKS

Amherst County is widely known and popular for its scenic beauty and natural settings. There are a variety of parks and trails within the county offering healthy "back-to-nature" experiences. The county maintains several parks in very attractive settings throughout the county. There are two on the historic James River and three are at the foot of the fabulous Blue Ridge Mountains.

*County park hours are sunrise and one hour after sunset. (Please note that county code stipulates that consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited on all county property).

COOLWELL PARK Located on Coolwell Road, south of the Town of Amherst, this recreational park has a picnic area with grills, a picnic shelter, a play area for children, restrooms, lighted all-purpose fields (soccer, football, and softball), outdoor basketball courts, a nature trail and an outdoor amphitheater.


MONACAN PARK This park is located on the scenic and historic James River. The park offers a boat ramp and boat

dock for access to the river, fishing benches, a covered picnic pavilion and picnic area, a play area for children and restroom facilities. It is located in the Elon area of the county. Directions: take Rt. 130 W. to Elon. Turn left on Monacan Park Rd. The park is located at the end of the Monacan Park Road.



RIVEREDGE PARK An exciting development for the county has been the enhancement and expansion of Riveredge Park, on the Madison Heights side of the James River directly across from Downtown Lynchburg. The newest addition to the park is the "BLUESTONE OUTDOOR AMPHITHEATER" located along the Riveredge Park Trail. The boat ramp at this park is used each year to launch the batteaux for the annual James River Batteau Festival. This park offers fishing access, along with comfort stations, picnic tables, a play area for children and a community center. This park is accessible by taking the first two lefthand turns at the bottom of the hill of Rt. 163 (old Rt. 29 bus., now called Old Town Connector) just before the bridge crossing into Downtown Lynchburg.

More improvements are planned for Riveredge Park. See News & Notes.

MILL CREEK LAKE PARK Located in the Temperance area of the county, this park is considered by many residents to be the most scenic with a clear view of Mt. Pleasant and is part of the Sleeping Giant Loop on the Virginia Birding and Wildlife Trail (www.dgif.virginia.gov) Furthermore, this park is extremely popular with the fishermen! It rests on a 190 acre watershed lake that is open for fishing and also has a swimming area. No gasoline powered boats allowed. The park consists of a boat ramp, picnic tables and grills, play area for children, swimming beach, floating dock and restroom facilities. Directions: turn onto Rt. 778 off of Rt. 60 west. Turn right on Rt. 610. Follow the signs.

STONEHOUSE LAKE PARK Located in the Temperance area of the county, this park rests on a beautiful 41 acre watershed lake and is open for fishing only (no swimming). This park is part of the Sleeping Giant Loop on the Virginia Birding and Wildlife Trail. (**www.dgif.virginia.gov**) There is a boat ramp providing access into the lake (no gasoline powered boats allowed). A covered picnic pavilion, picnic tables and grills, a play area for children and restroom facilities makes this park an attractive setting for family/group picnics and activities. Directions: turn on Rt. 778 off of Rt. 60 W. Turn left onto Rt. 610. Follow the signs.

THRASHERS LAKE PARK

Located in the Temperance area of the county, this park rests on an attractive 36 acre watershed lake open for fishing only (no swimming). This park is part

of the Sleeping

Giant Loop on

the Virginia



Birding and Wildlife Trail (www.dgif.virginia.gov). It consists of a boat ramp (no gasoline powered boats allowed) picnic tables and grills, a play area for children and restroom facilities. Directions: turn onto Rt. 778 off of Rt. 60 W. Turn left on Rt 610. Follow the signs.

HIKING

RIVEREDGE TRAIL This newest addition to the county trail system is a blacktop hiking/biking trail that extends .4 miles along the James River from Riveredge Park. The county is planning to continue the extension of this trail as property and funds become available.

JAMES RIVER HERITAGE TRAIL This blacktop hiking/

biking trail is part of the Peaks of Otter Loop on the Virginia Birding and Wildlife Trail (www. dgif.virginia. gov) and has two access points. One is from Percival Island Natural Area in Lynchburg. The trail extends from Lynchburg's Blackwater Creek Trail, crossing the railroad trestle onto Percival Isle from Lynchburg. It traverses the island for about



one mile along an old railroad bed. The trail continues across the James River on another trestle, and continues along the James River in Amherst County for another 1 ½ miles. This is a beautiful scenic walk or bike ride through an historical

area. The trail is also accessible in Amherst County at the end of Fertilizer Road [enter via the Central Virginia Training School]. Be sure to explore the exhibit, VIRGINIA ROCKS, at the JRHT trailhead at the base of Fertilizer Road.

VIRGINIA BLUE RIDGE RAILWAY TRAIL This trail is idyllically located in the rolling Virginia countryside and follows the banks of the Piney and Tye Rivers along the path of the longest running, commercially successful short-line railway in America. It is part of the Sleeping Giant Loop on the Virginia Birding and Wildlife Trail (www.dgif.virginia.

gov). This trail extends 7 miles for hikers, bikers, and horseback riders and provides a perfect opportunity to relive the historically significant events that developed and changed Amherst and Nelson Counties. The



two access points are located at Piney River and Roses Mill in nearby Nelson County.

BROTHER BASIL NATURE TRAIL Located at Coolwell Park, this ¼ mile trail is located behind the outdoor amphitheater. Go exploring and check it out!

APPALACHIAN TRAIL Approximately 25 miles of this trail passes through Amherst County from the Nelson County line to the James River, crossing over the James River Foot

Bridge into Bedford County. There are many beautiful and scenic trails that run through the mountains of the county. Enjoy the sights from Mt. Pleasant, Cole Mountain, Tar Jacket, and Rocky Row Run, just to name a few.

HENRY LANUM MEMORIAL TRAIL Located in the Mount Pleasant National Scenic Area, this 4.8 mile loop leads to the 4,071 foot summit of Mount Pleasant with panoramic 360 degree views high atop Amherst County!

OLD HOTEL TRAIL A 5-mile loop, when combined with

the Appalachian Trail, across the meadows on the summit of Cole Mountain with fantastic views of the Amherst foothills and the western valley.

VIRGINIA BIRDING & WILDLIFE

TRAIL From the Atlantic Ocean of Virginia's eastern border, to the towering Mt. Rogers at its southwest corner, the Commonwealth includes every bird and animal habitat that occurs naturally between Maine and Florida. Virginia also offers a long history, rich culture,

and tradition of warm hospitality to welcome visitors. Within Virginia's 43,000 square miles of diverse natural habitat, you can find some 400 species of birds, 250 species of fish, 150 species of terrestrial and marine animals, 150 species of amphibians and reptiles, and a wide variety of aquatic and terrestrial invertebrates. The Virginia Birding and Wildlife Trail celebrates this diversity. In fact, it is the first statewide program of its kind in the United States. All three phases of the trail link wildlife viewing sites throughout the state have been



completed: The Coastal, Piedmont, and Mountain Phases. Amherst County has several trail loops listed inthe Mountain Phase trail system. The Peaks of Otter Loop includes the James River Heritage Trail along the southern border of the county. The Sleeping Giant Loop, includes Mt. Pleasant Scenic Area, Mill Creek Lake, Stonehouse Lake, Thrashers Lake, as well as the Virginia Blue Ridge Railway Trail. 



The Amherst Masonic Lodge, Clinton Lodge #73, presented Executive Director of the Amherst County Habitat For humanity, Debbie Habel, with the Grand Masters Community Builders award last September, 2021.

A life-long resident of Amherst County, graduate of Amherst County High School and Central Virginia Community College, Habel has owned and operated several businesses over the years and previously worked in the Amherst County Commissioner of the Revenue Office handling real estate transfers, wills, land use program and assessing new construction.

Habel became the director of Amherst County Habitat in September 2015 after serving as board president. On the organization's behalf, she served as construction manager for the Amherst Disaster Recovery Group following the April 2018 tornado that struck Elon and left 45 homes destroyed with approximately 30 of those being uninsured or underinsured.

Amherst County Habitat brought in more than \$100,000 in donated building materials and a grant for \$23,000 to be used in the tornado recovery process and the last home was finished in March 2020 before the COVID-19 shutdown.

Amherst County Habitat For Humanity was formed in 1992 and serves those in the range of 30% to 60% of median income using volunteer labor.

After operating from downtown Amherst offices for several years, the Amherst County Habitat offices are located in the former Rehab Associates building, donated by Centra, located at 130 Ambriar Court, adjacent to the Ambriar Shopping Center. With the additional space, they have opened an ongoing Indoor Yard Sale, with limited hours, selling donated household and construction items! The property currently has three houses, two of which are being rented out. One of the houses could eventually become a wedding venue with beautiful



A permaculture farm was established onsite in 2019, with the goal of supplying as many food and beer ingredients as possible, right down to the yeast harvested off the property. Honeybees, berries, greens, herbs, tomatoes, and other specialty

fruits and vegetables are all sustainably raised here. Visitors to Camp Trapezium are encouraged to roam the property and view the farm from which their food comes.

Accomplishing thiswhile also bringing the building up to code was a challenge, but with the support and partnership of the town and county, we've succeeded."

The Economic Development Authority of Amherst County, the Town of Amherst, Amherst County, and Virginia Department of Environmental Quality were instrumental in bringing this project to fruition. Waukeshaw worked closely with Amherst County and the Planning Commission through the rezoning and regulatory process and received a grant from the Virginia Brownfields Assistance Fund from the Department of Environmental Quality for environmental remediation work.

"We're thrilled to have Camp Trapezium as part of the Town of Amherst, and to see the iconic Amherst mill brought back to life" said Sara Carter, Amherst Town Manager.

"Working with Trapezium to bring this project to fruition has been an excellent experience," said Amherst County Administrator, Dean Rodgers. "I know that this place will be an economic driver for the County, and for the region."



JRA also announced plans for improvements at Riveredge Park to establish the Upper James River Center. The Upper James River Center will turn the existing building into a state-of-the-art environmental education center to strengthen current education programs and serve as a focal point for river activities in the region.

"Amherst County Public Schools has been a partner with the James River Association for the past four years," said Dr. William Wells, Assistant Superintendent of Amherst County Public Schools. 

Improvements at the Boxwood Farm Convenience Center are finished, and the site is now fully operational.

Additions to the location included two trash compactors, one cardboard compactor, and a metal/paper/mixed paper recycling container. Boxwood Farm Convenience Center is the location of the County's first plastic/aluminum self-contained compactor. The dual compactor has two doors, one for plastic and one for aluminum, and will increase the site's efficiency by taking up less space than two separate compactors. 





Amherst County Habitat for Humanity is pleased to be a part of a statewide Capital Campaign. This coordination between 20 Virginia Habitat affiliates is a unique & exciting journey towards stronger communities throughout Virginia.

Our Need:

- 1: According to the latest census, Amherst County has 13% of its population under the Federal poverty guidelines, the state average is 10%. We have 56% of our population in the ALICE category (Asset Limited Income Constrained Employed) where the state average is 29%. The need for affordable housing is REAL.
- 2: We serve those in the 30% to 60% of median income for Amherst County. With volunteer labor and 0% interest mortgages, we provide affordable housing thus

easing budget restraints on families...improving lives through better health, removing food insecurities, providing stability, education, technology access, redirecting generational poverty.



LU Serves...Liberty University service group working with Amherst Habitat on the Depot Street Revitalization Project in conjunction with the Town of Amherst.



- 1: Establish a land inventory through land purchases and land donations.
- 2: Doubling the homes built annually, thus increasing our monthly mortgage revenue and improving the quality of life for our County residents in need.

Our Accomplishments:

- 1: Awarded a HUD Capacity Grant, 1 of 15 approved in the United States. This grant funds the salary for an additional full-time employee for 3 years which allowed us to start an entire new application process for Health & Safety Critical Repairs.
- 2: We Moved! Our offices are now located in the former Rehab Associates building, donated by Centra, located at 130 Ambriar Court. With the additional space, we have opened an ongoing Indoor Yardsale, selling donated household and construction items! We also partner with Social Services, Disabled Veterans, abuse shelters, disaster victims, area churches, etc.

- 3: We have established Homebuyer's Club Financial classes, 12 hours of instruction prior to the application process. With our latest graduates, 3 families raised their personal credit scores over 200 points each!
- 4: Established an Apostle's Build Program forming a building partnership with area churches.
- 5: Started our first Neighborhood Revitalization Project covering approximately a 10 block area of Depot Street in conjunction with the Town of Amherst. (see pictures)
- 6: We were awarded Virginia State Tax Credits (NAP Credits). Our Board has established the following guidelines for 2021-22: When making a \$5000 minimum donation to Amherst County Habitat the donor receives \$2500 tax deduction and a \$2500 Virginia State Tax Credit.


